Ways to Give Generously to Central Baptist Church

- Life Insurance where the church is named either as the beneficiary or as owner/beneficiary of the life insurance policy.
- Retirement Assets where the church is named as the beneficiary of the retirement plan or IRA. Upon death, the allocated funds move to the church tax-free.


